



Emergency First Aid at Work (EFAW)



Overview

This one day course covers the role of designated First Aid Appointed Person to include looking after the equipment and facilities and calling the Emergency Services when required. Arrangements should be made for an Appointed Person to be available to undertake these duties at all times when people are at work.

Target Group

This course is aimed at those with a less hazardous working environment who do not require a qualified First Aider, but need to appoint a person to take charge of first aid arrangements and emergency first aid.

Objectives

By the end of this course, delegates will be able to demonstrate the skills necessary to deal with emergency situations within the workplace, to include responsibility of equipment and facilities.

Course Content

The course covers the following areas / topics;

- ✕ Responsibilities and Reporting
- ✕ Assessment of the situation
- ✕ Dealing with an unconscious casualty
- ✕ Resuscitation
- ✕ Heart Attacks
- ✕ Choking
- ✕ Control of Bleeding
- ✕ Fractures
- ✕ Burns
- ✕ Shock

In addition to the core subjects as listed above, an additional 1 hour is available to cover specific areas that are appropriate to your organisation.

Outcomes

There is no exam as the trainer will assess each individual ongoing throughout the course. All delegates will receive a certificate of attendance. This qualification is valid for 3 years.
