



Overview

This one day course gives managers an understanding and introduction to the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations 2002. Delegates will learn how to undertake and record a COSHH assessment and identify the actions required when dealing with hazardous substances.

Target Group

This course is designed for line managers, supervisors, safety representatives and anyone with responsibility for the control of exposure to chemical and biological hazards in the workplace.
